This two-unit course, open first to TCS/CDM/FMS majors, centers on two **required** day-long field trips to the San Francisco International Film Festival (Friday April 29 & Sat April 30) - one of the US's largest, most prestigious international film festivals, where students will attend a special "College Days" program of film screenings, participate in question and answer sessions with featured filmmakers, and take part in panel discussions presented by the festival's educational programming department. Students must also attend one class meeting before the festival and one meeting afterwards.

NOTE: STUDENT TICKETS / total required costs for this two-day field trip total approximately \$85.

This 198 is offered in tandem to Prof Wyman's First Year Seminar of the same name – allowing filmmaking and film and media studies students to take part in this field trip. Spaces are limited and enrollment requires instructor permission. NOTE that There is a special need for DRIVERS of University Vans for the festival, and FREE film tickets are provided for drivers.
