Carter (UC-Davis alum, MFA 1997) is best known for his artwork that spans various media from painting and sculpture to photography, film and video. His works have been exhibited internationally including at the Whitney Museum of American Art in New York, Museum of Modern Art, New York, Tate Modern, London, San Francisco Museum of Modern Art, the USA Today and Abstract America exhibitions at the Saatchi Gallery in London, England. His works have also been shown at the The Royal Academy in London and Museion in Bolzano, Italy.

Dan Spencer is a San Francisco-based artist and educator who trained in studio art at Wesleyan University and UC Davis, who has shown his painting and fiber sculpture nationally and in recent years has expanded his practice to include performance. Spencer has organized events and performed as part of the group CAPITALISM IS OVER!
